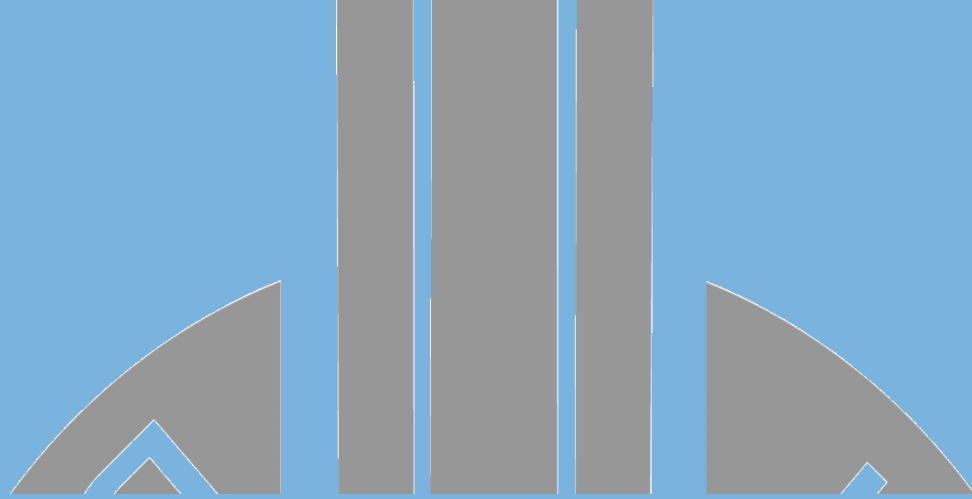
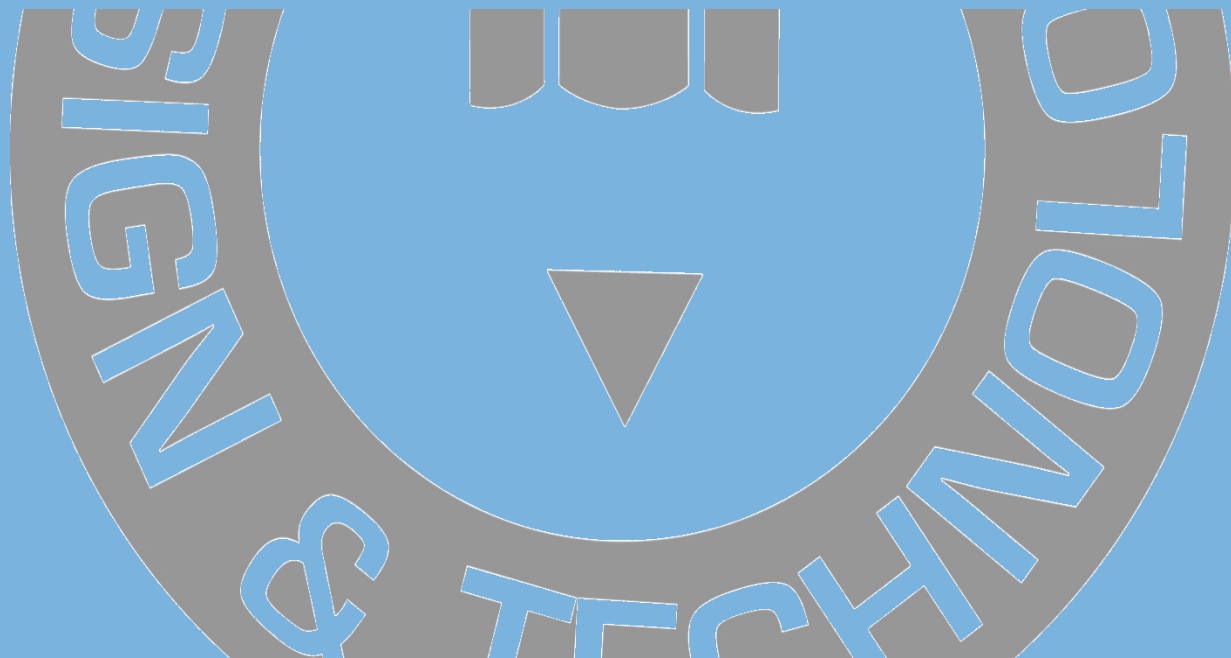

If you have a sewing machine at home, perhaps you could practice sewing on a spare piece of fabric.



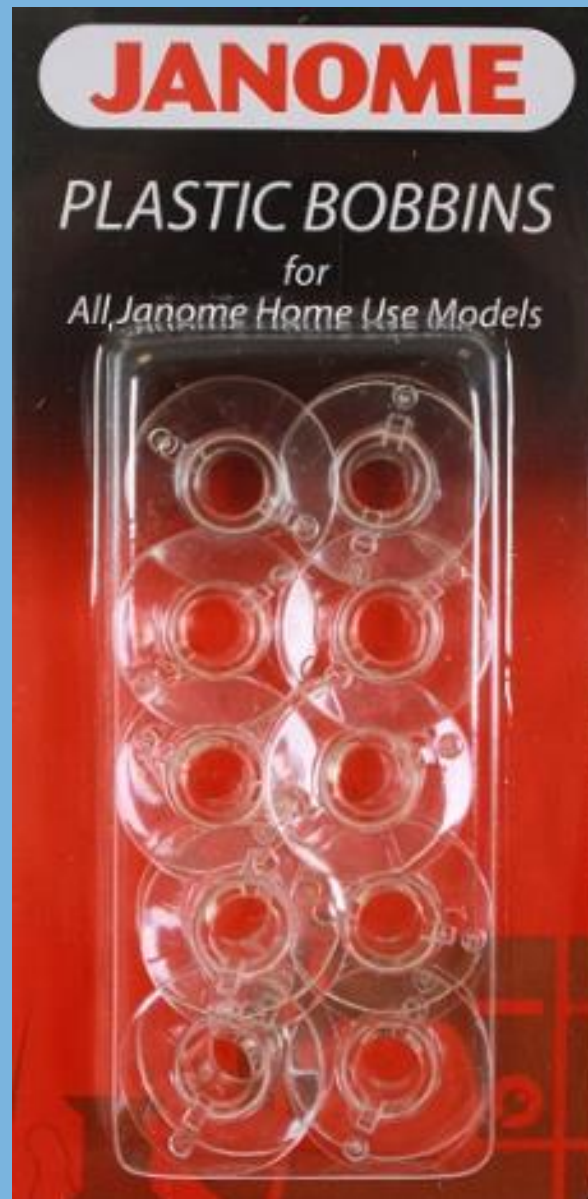

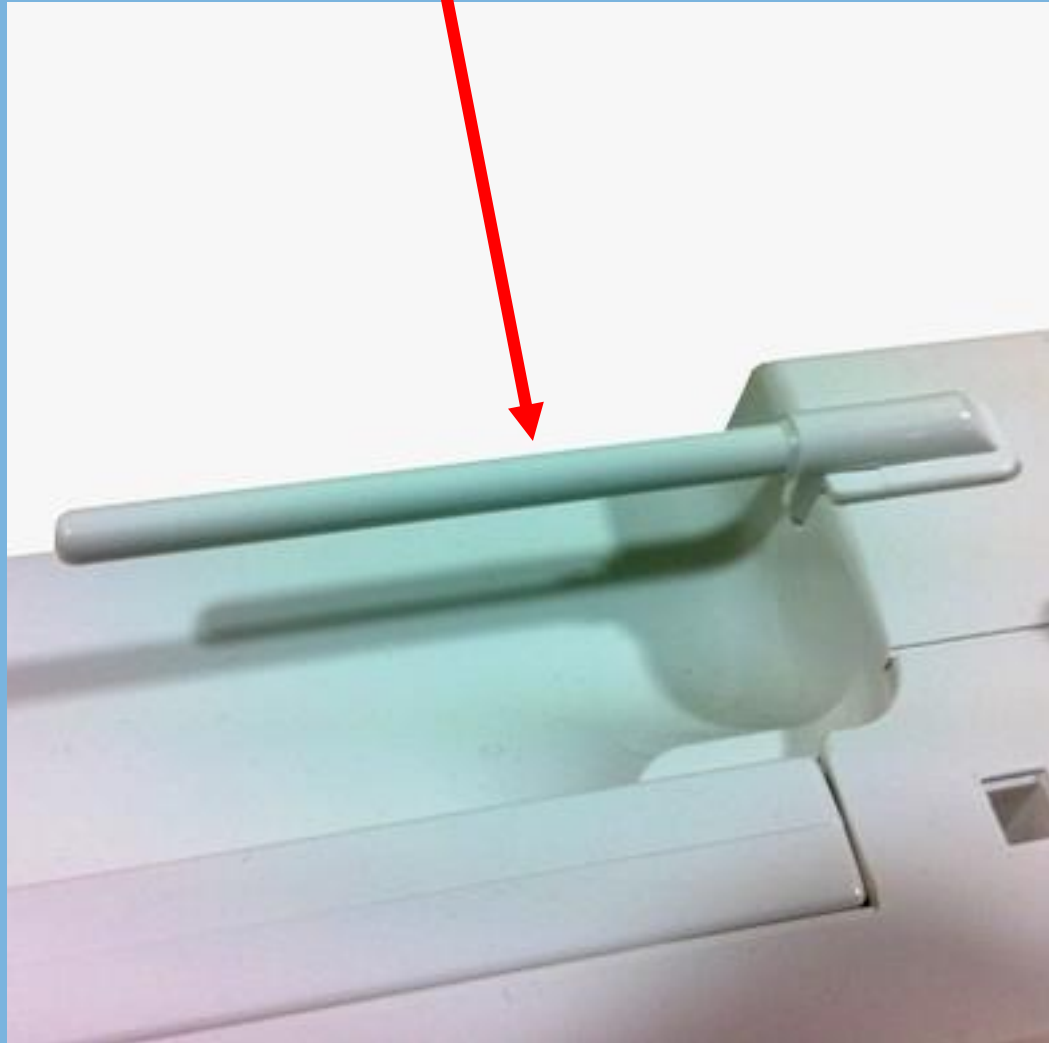

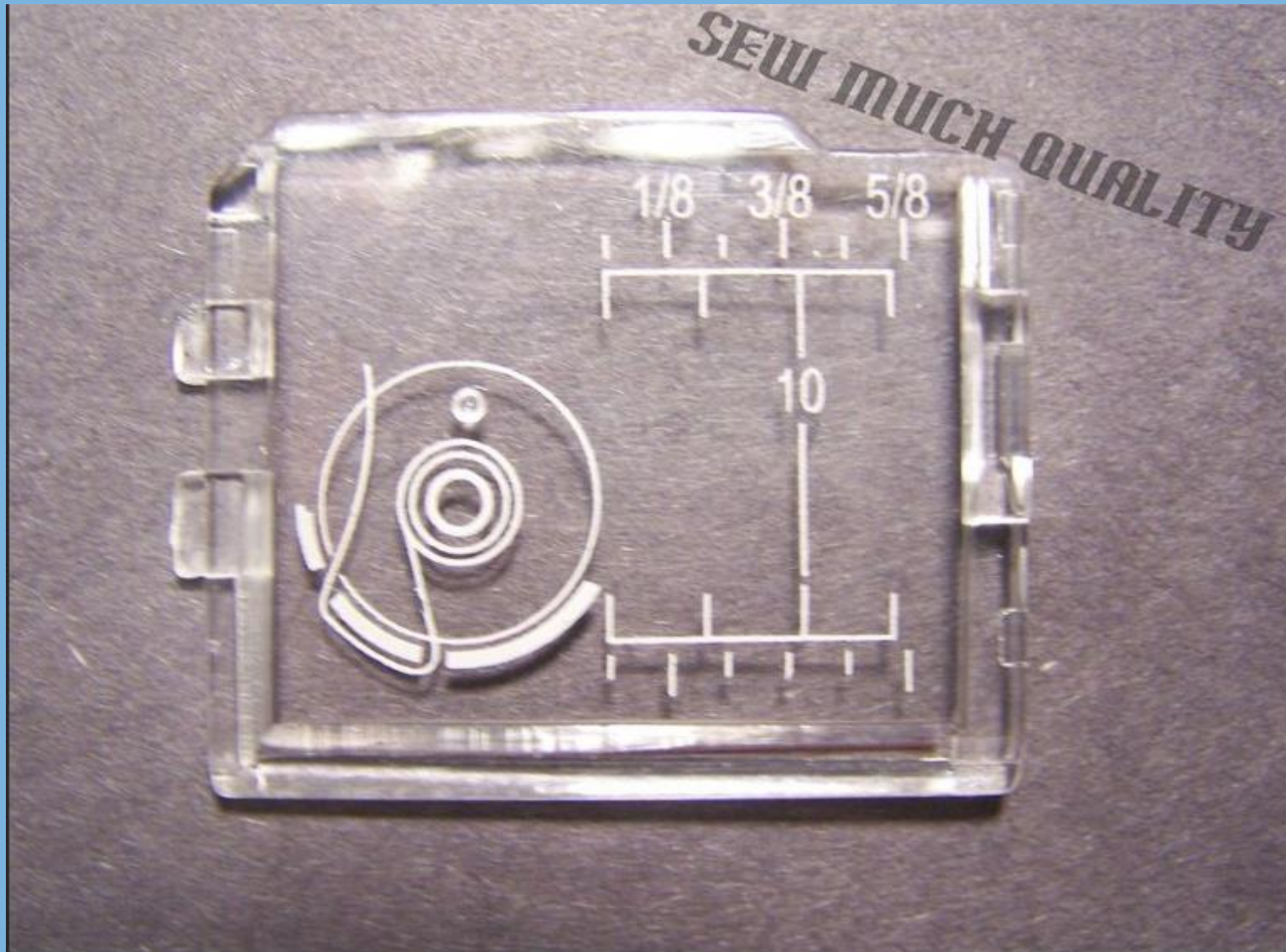

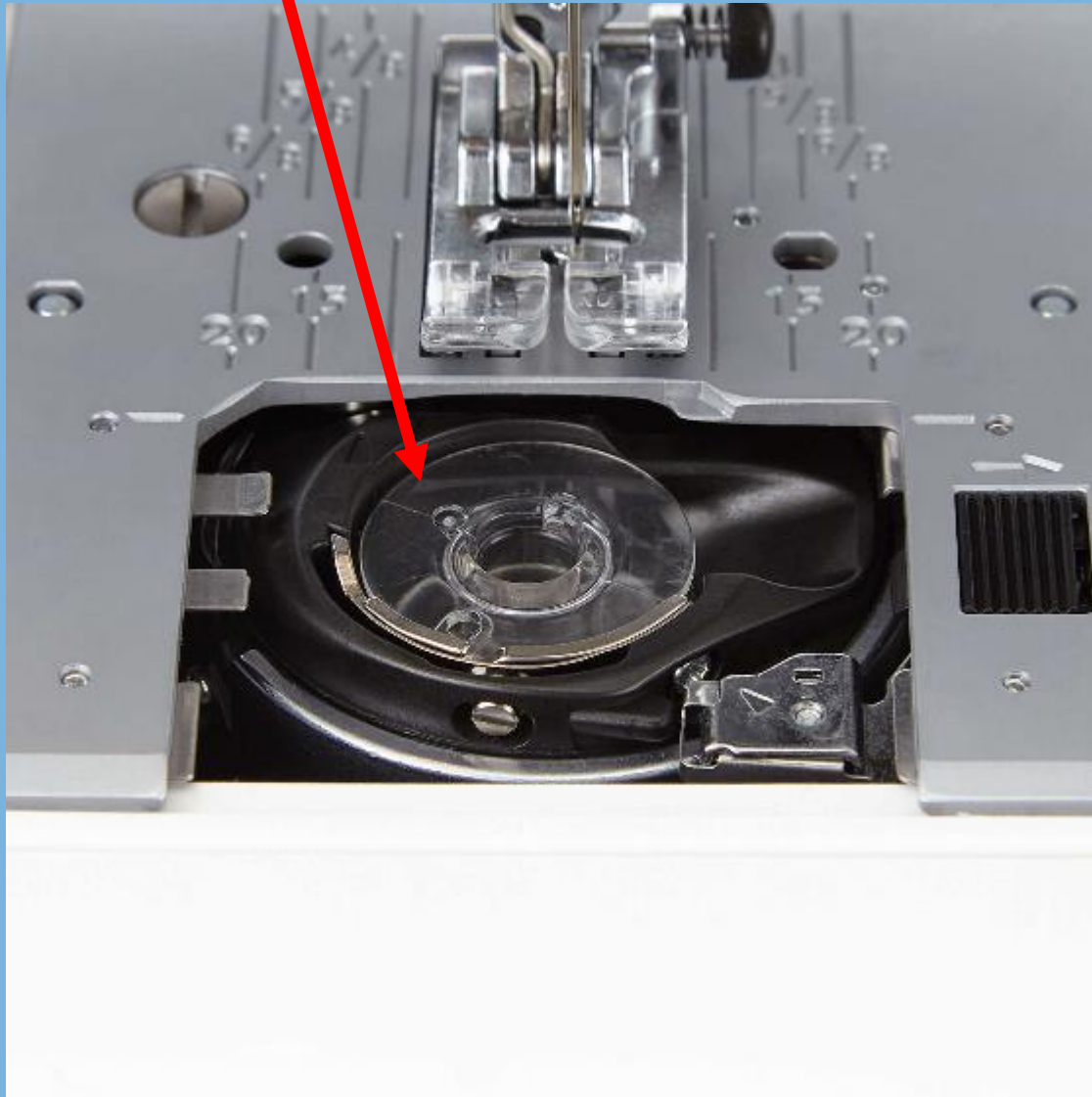

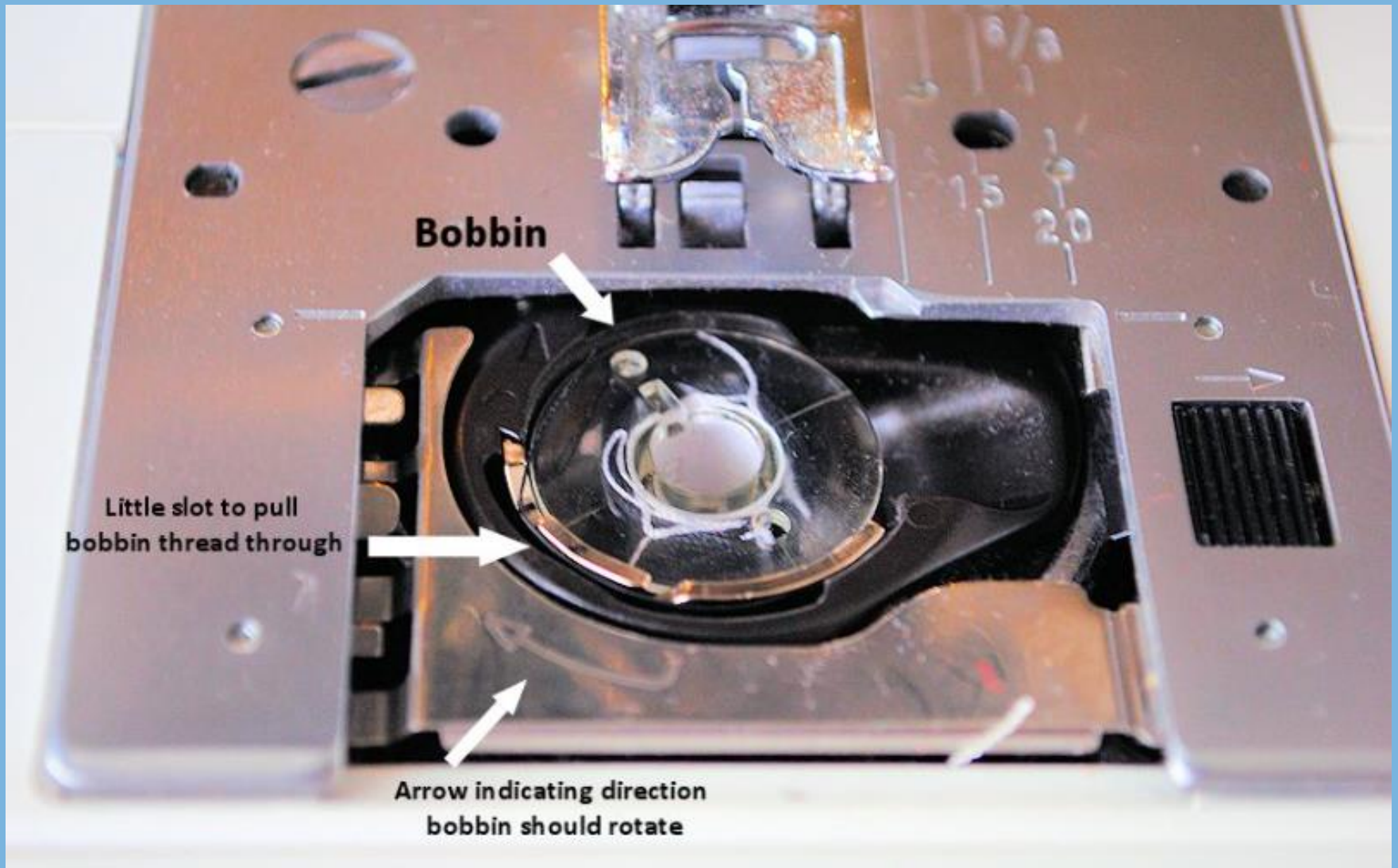

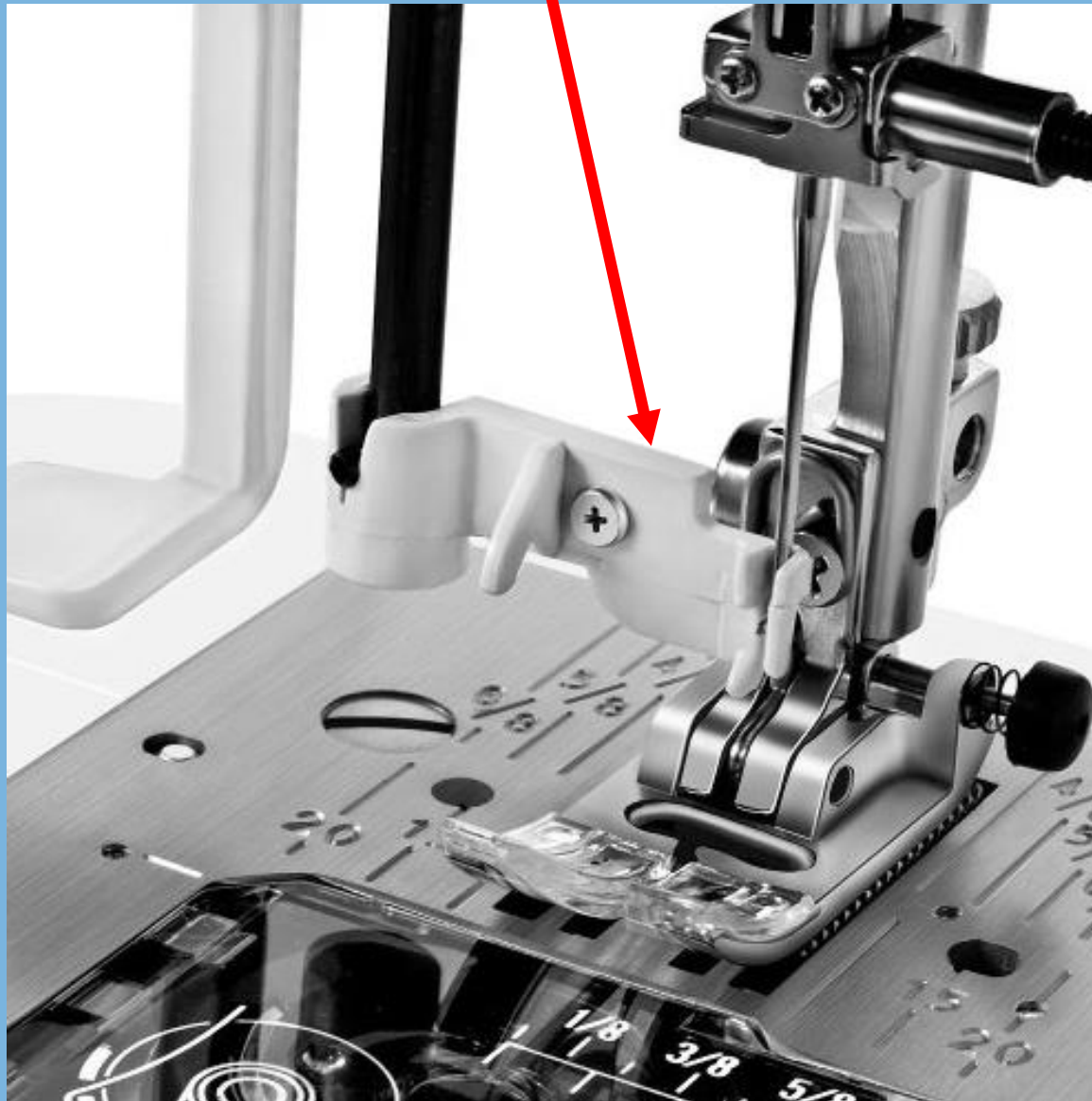

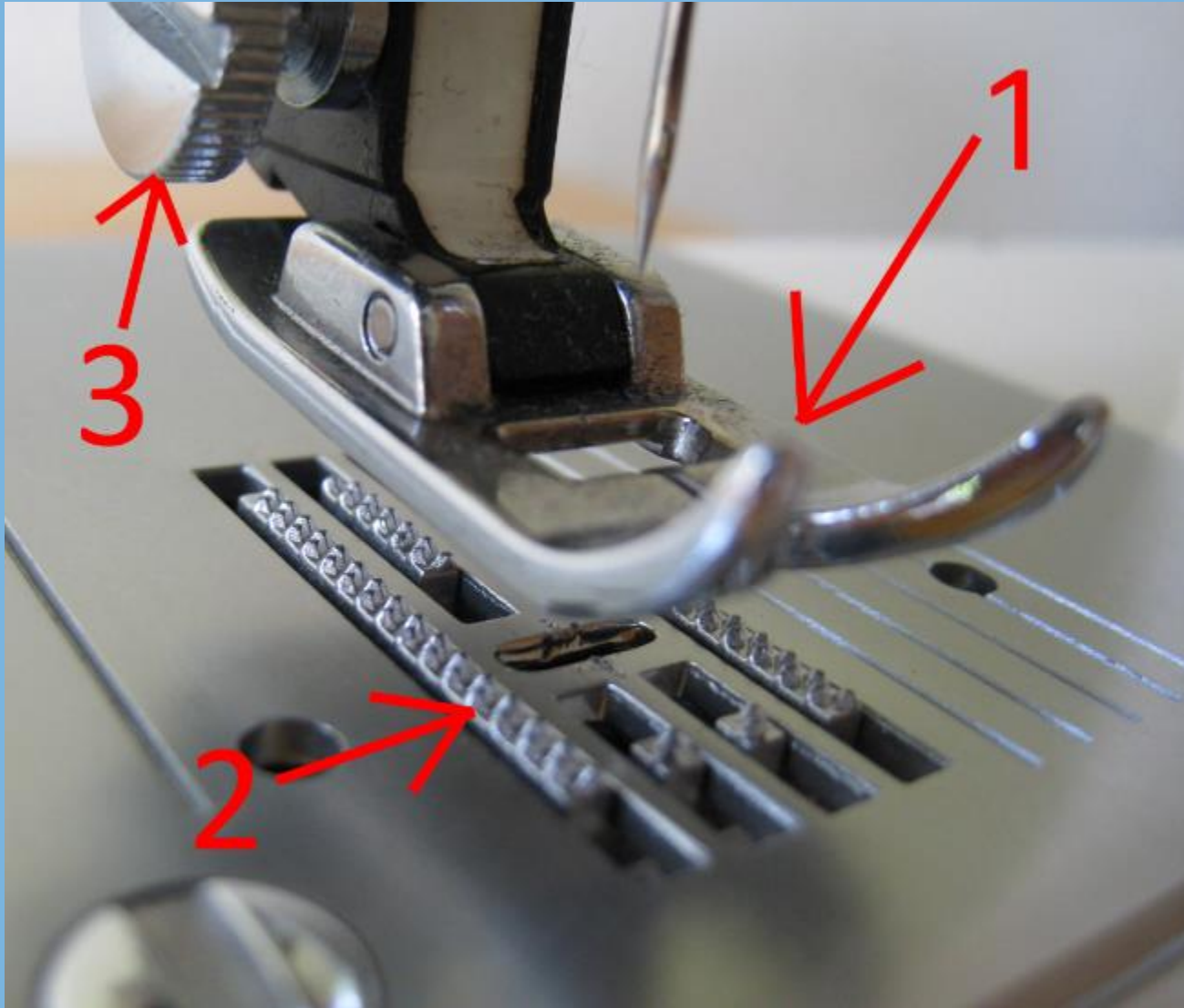

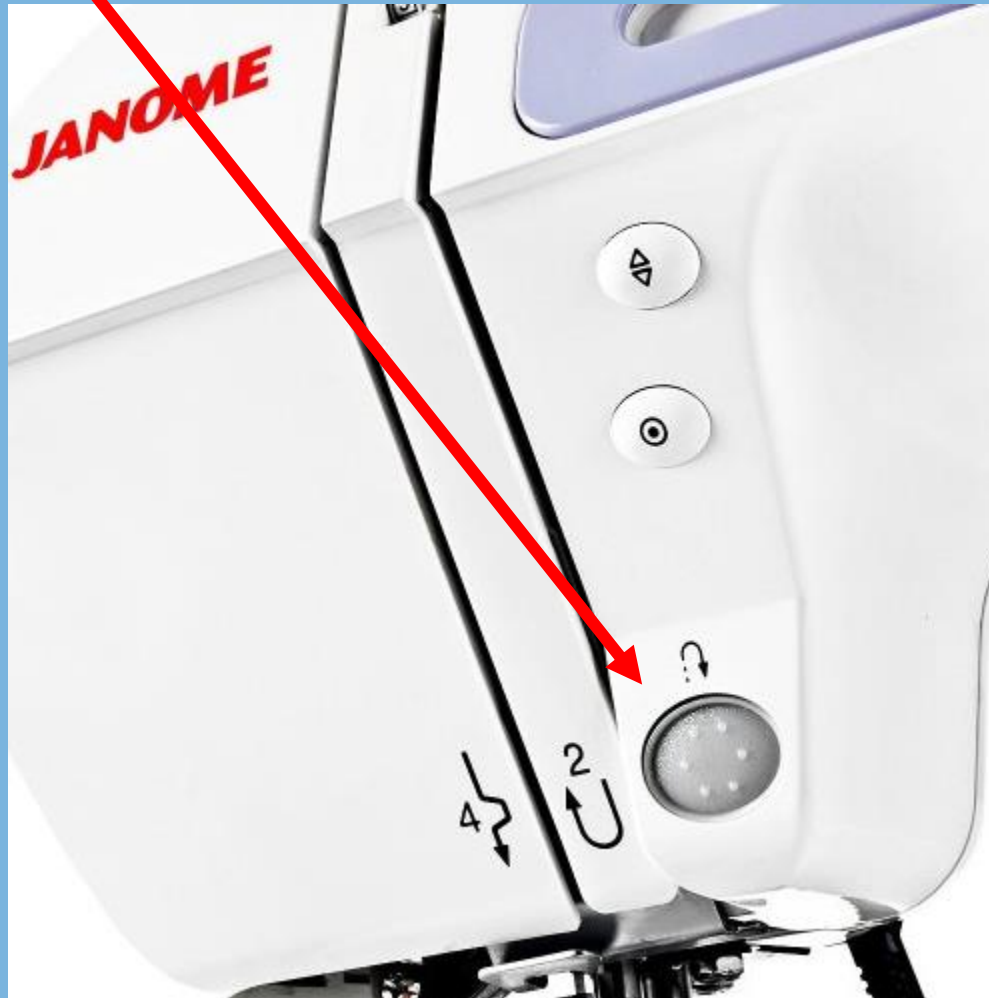

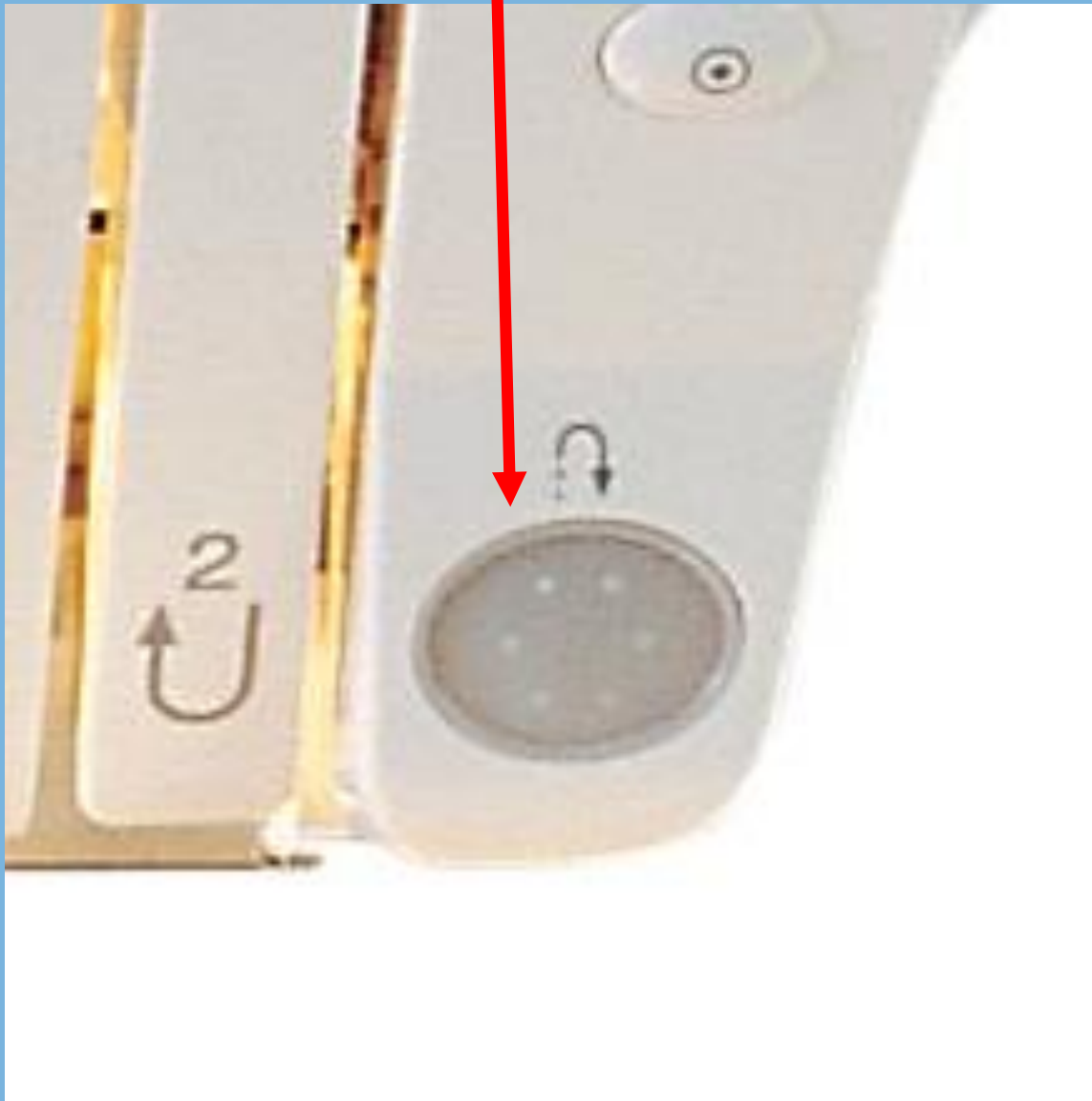

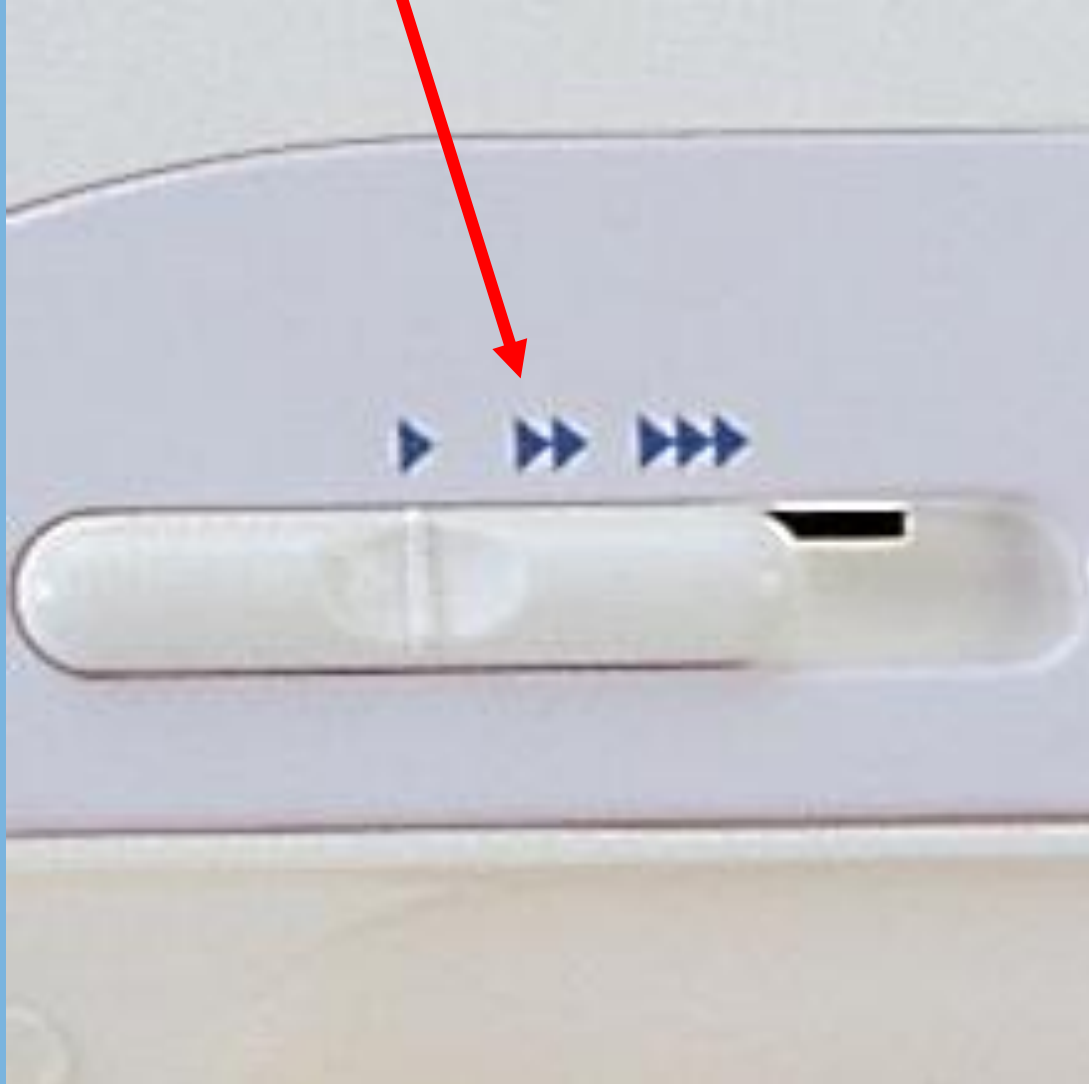

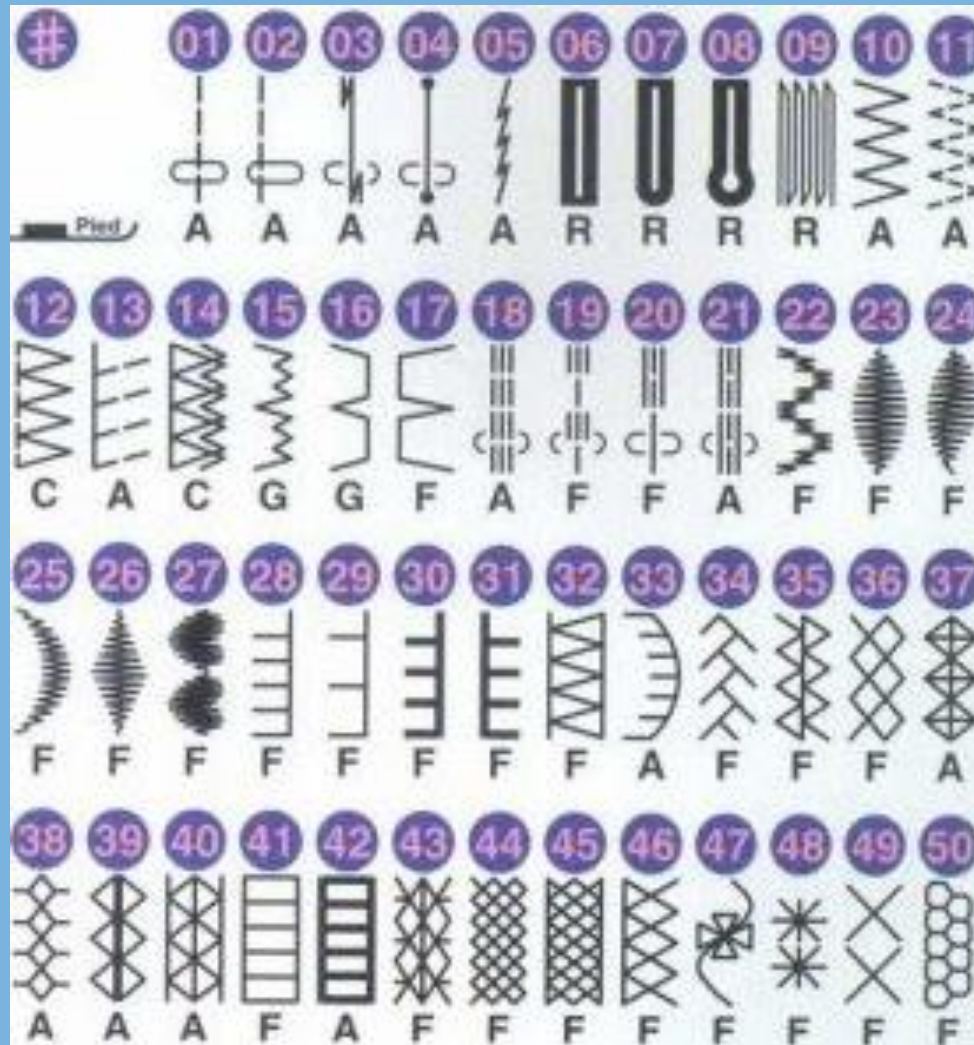

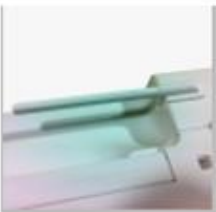

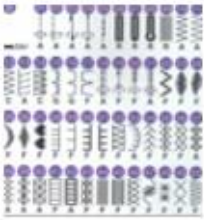

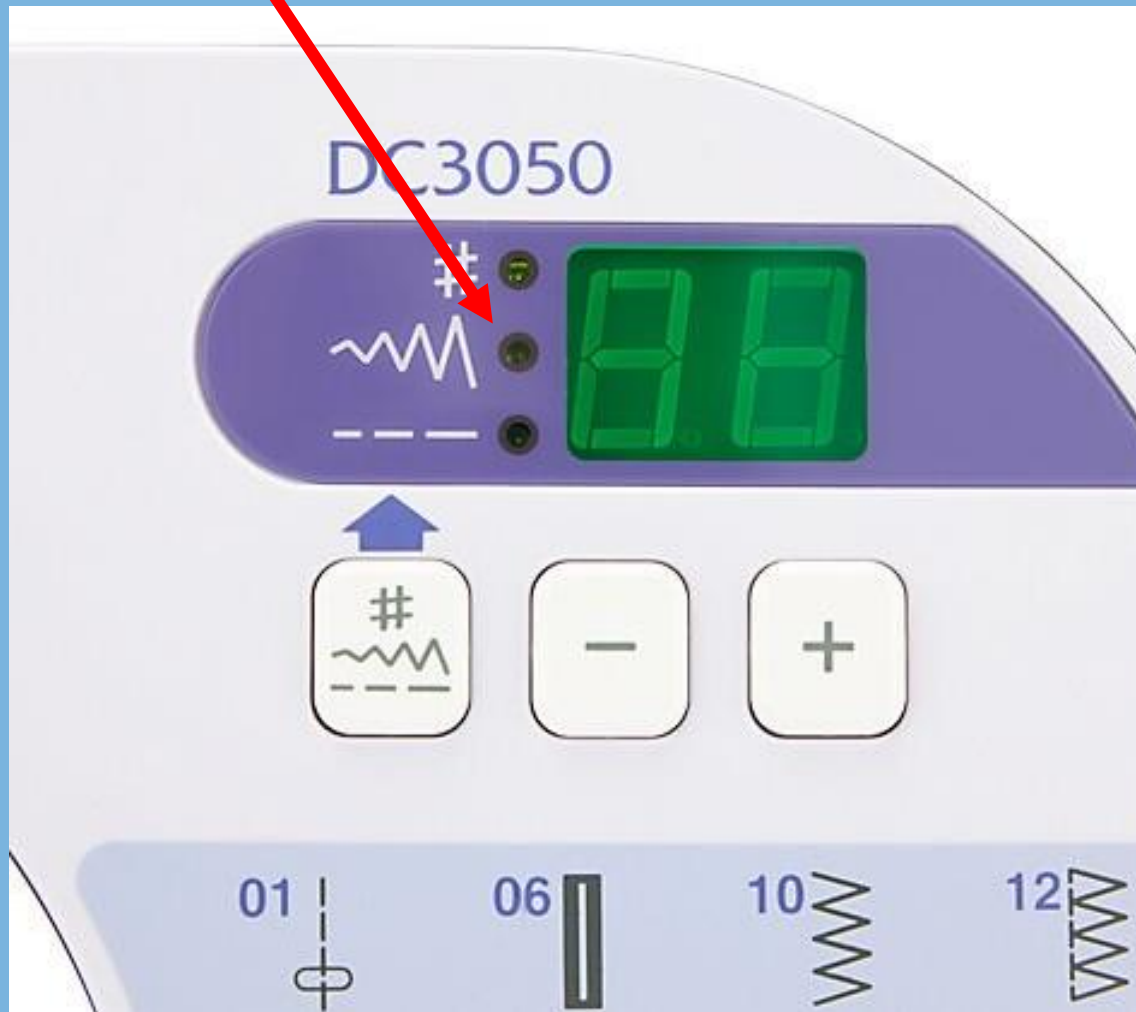

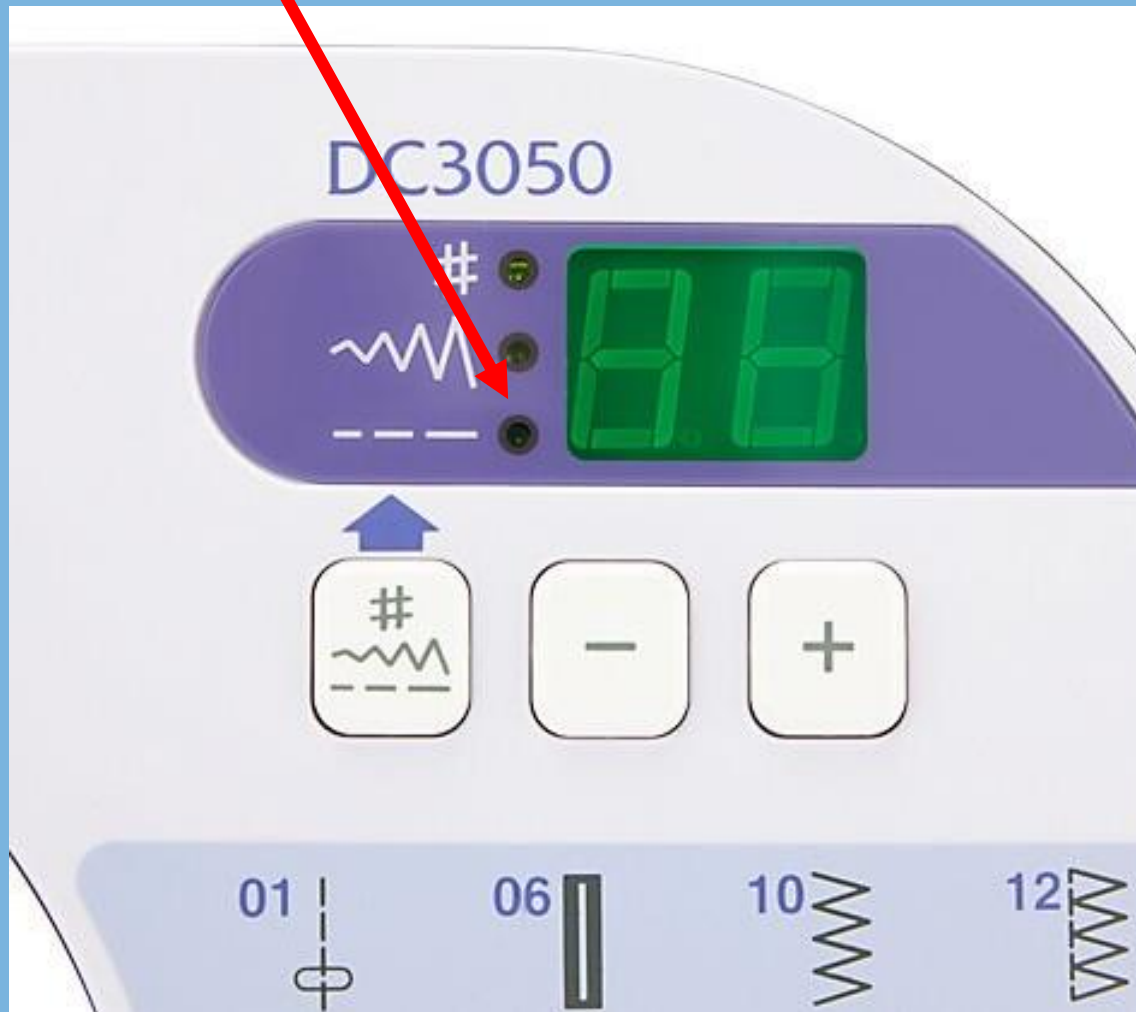
Top Light # Indicates The Stitch Number Selected



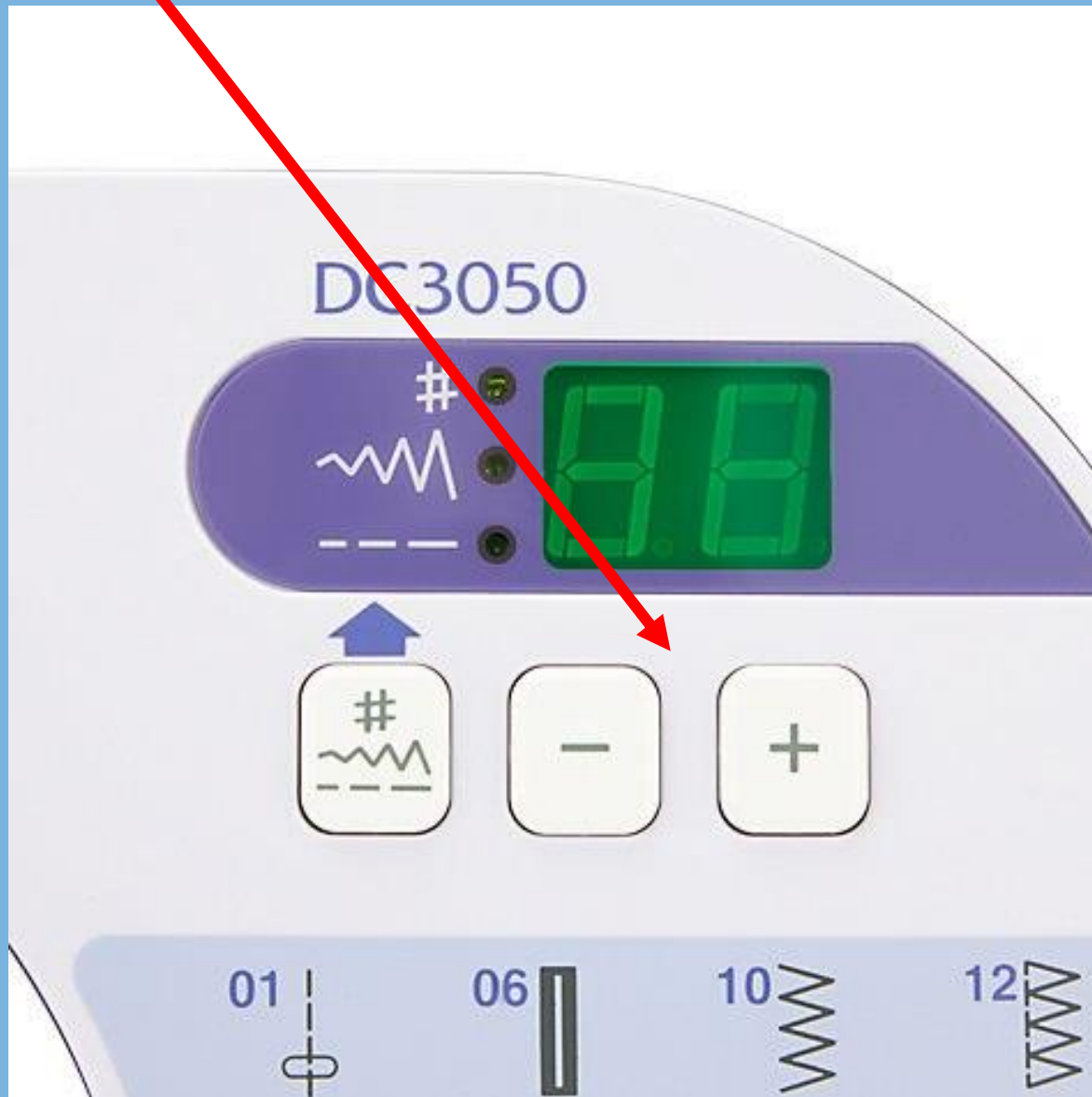
Middle Light = Stitch Width



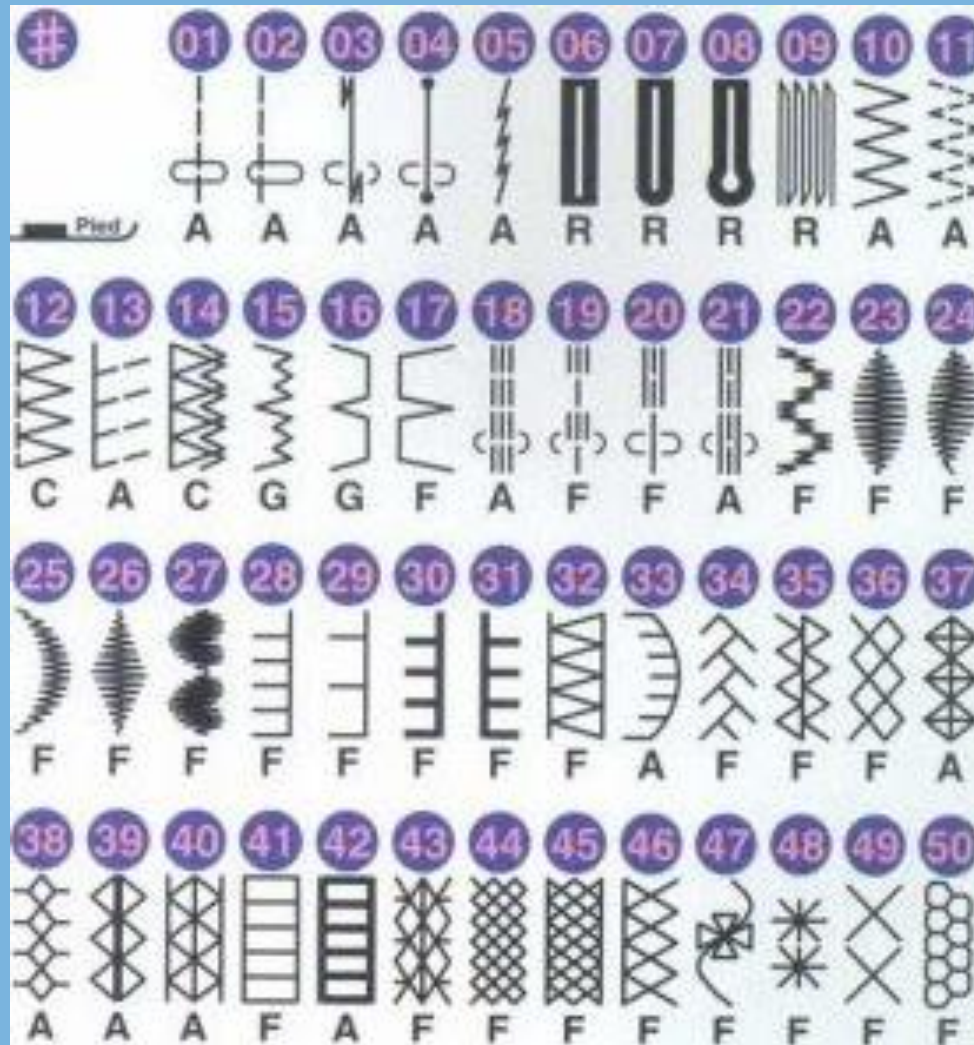
Bottom Light = Stitch Length



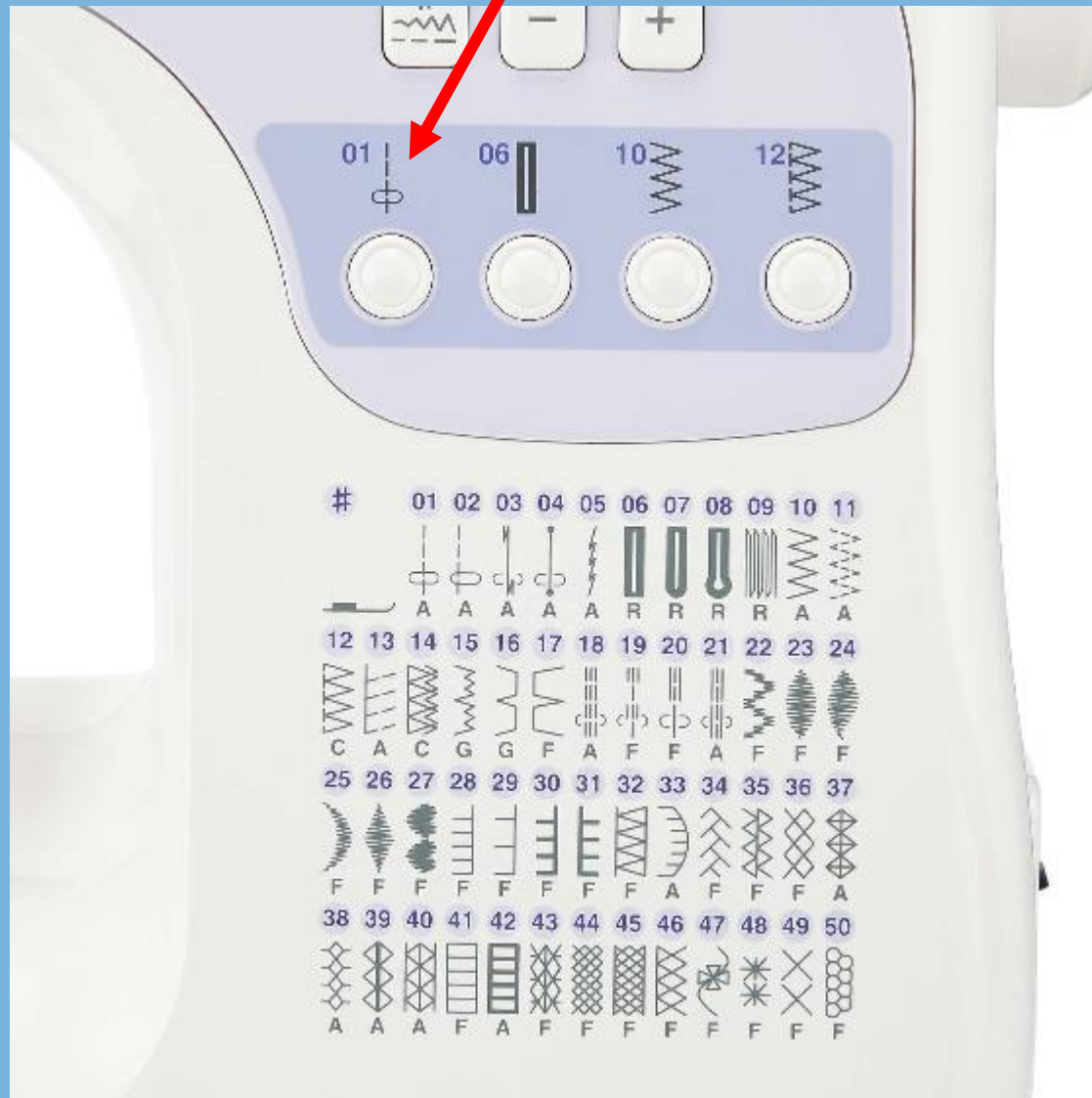

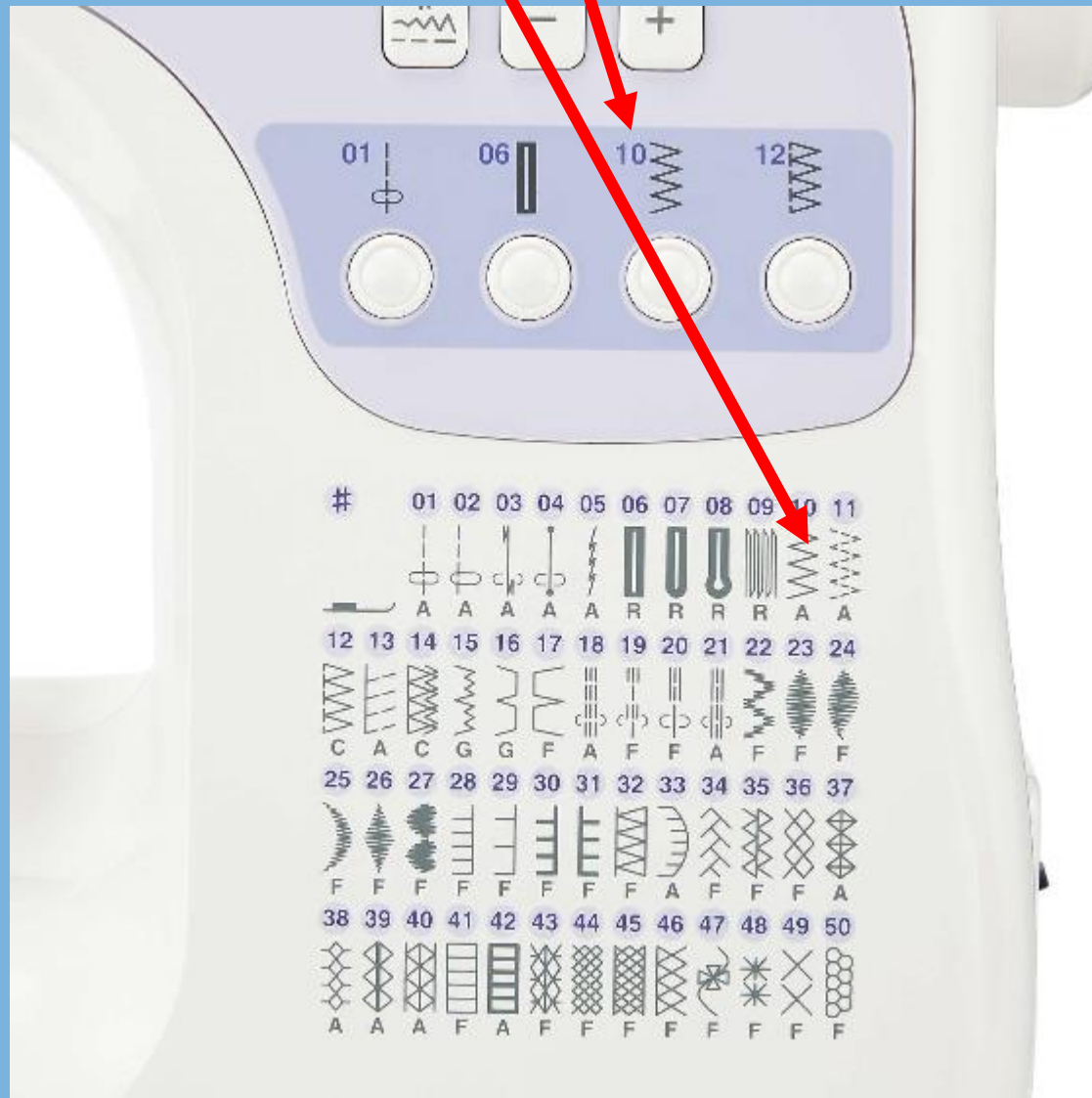




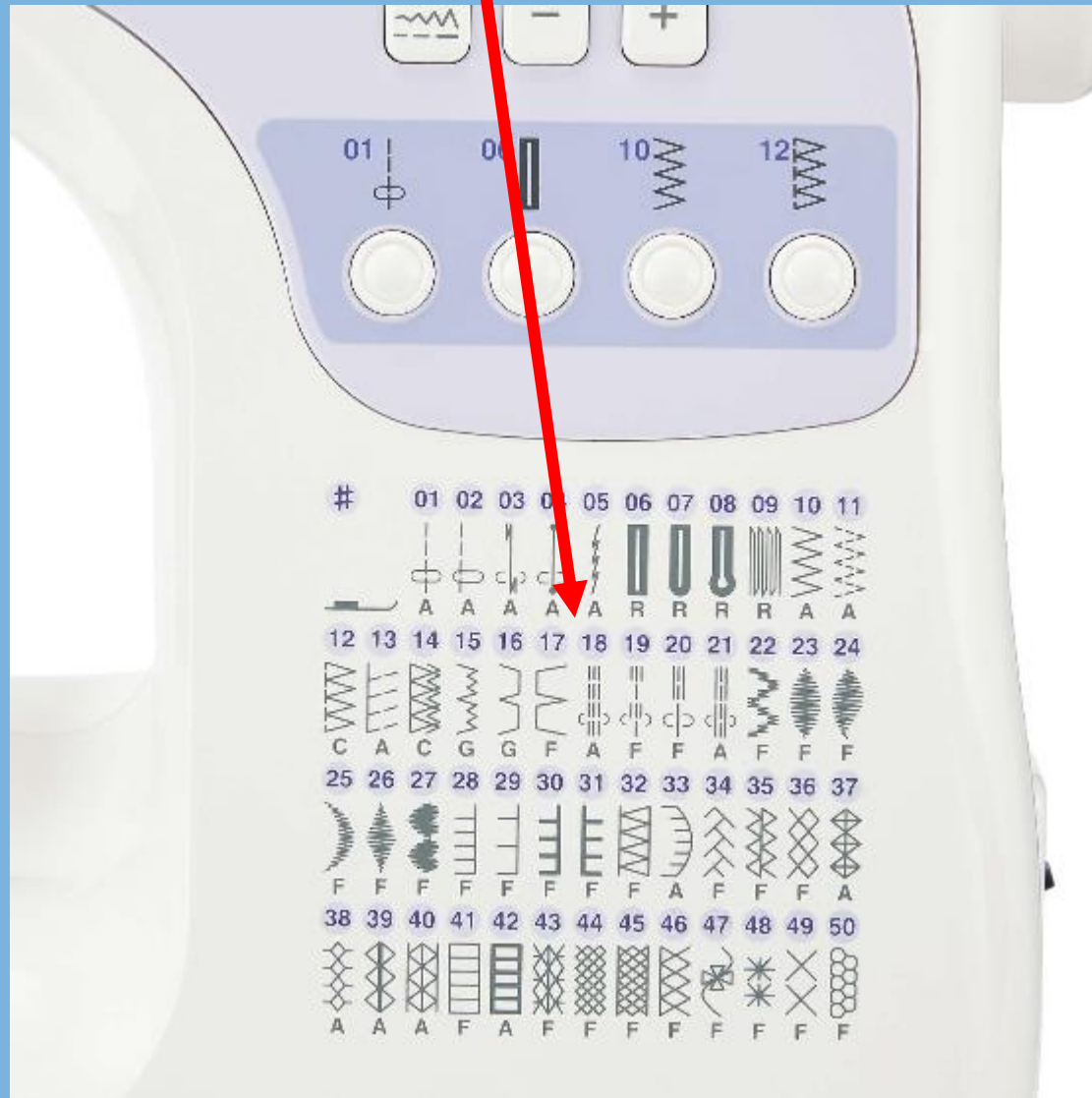
Straight Stitch #1

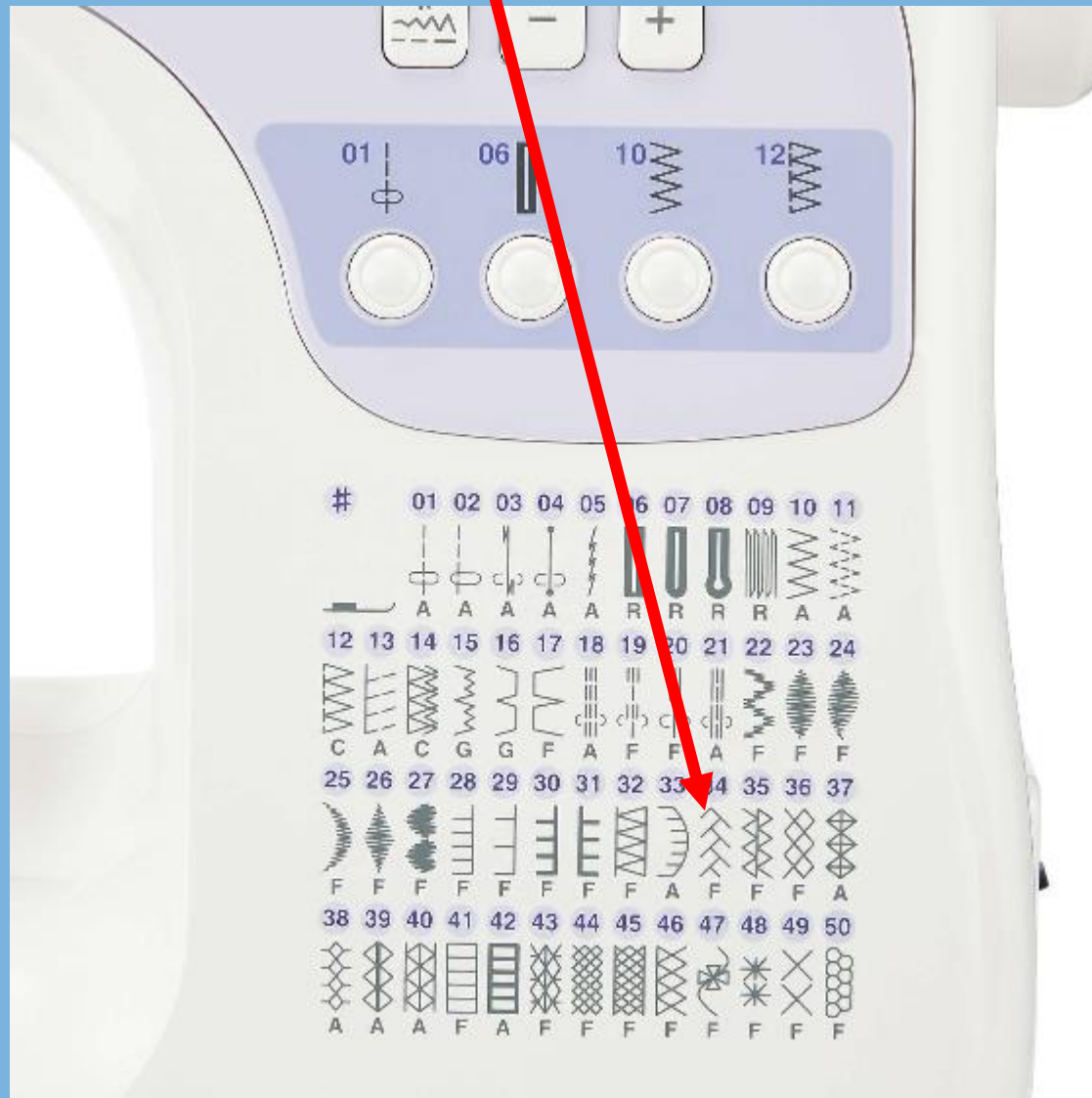

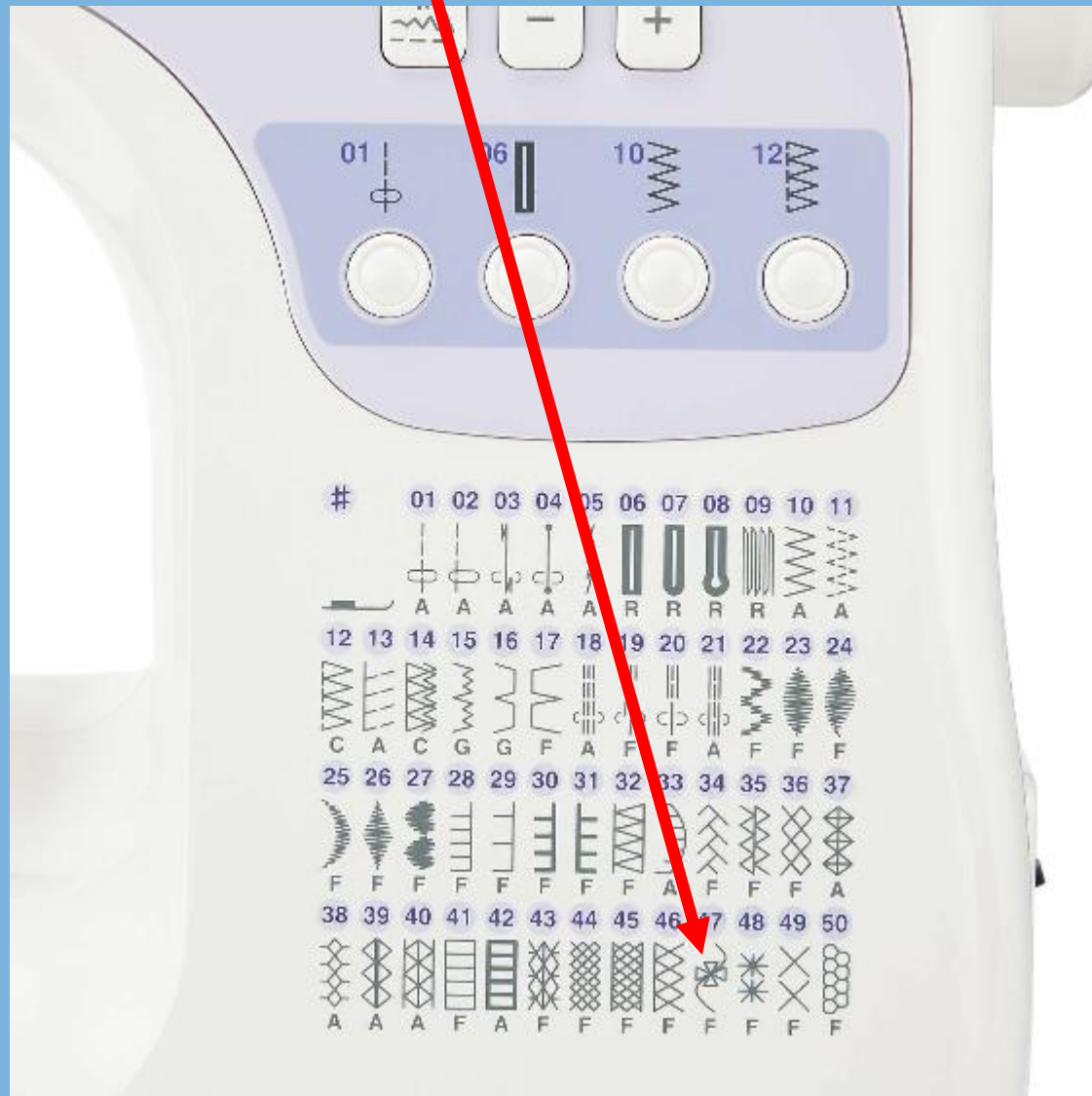

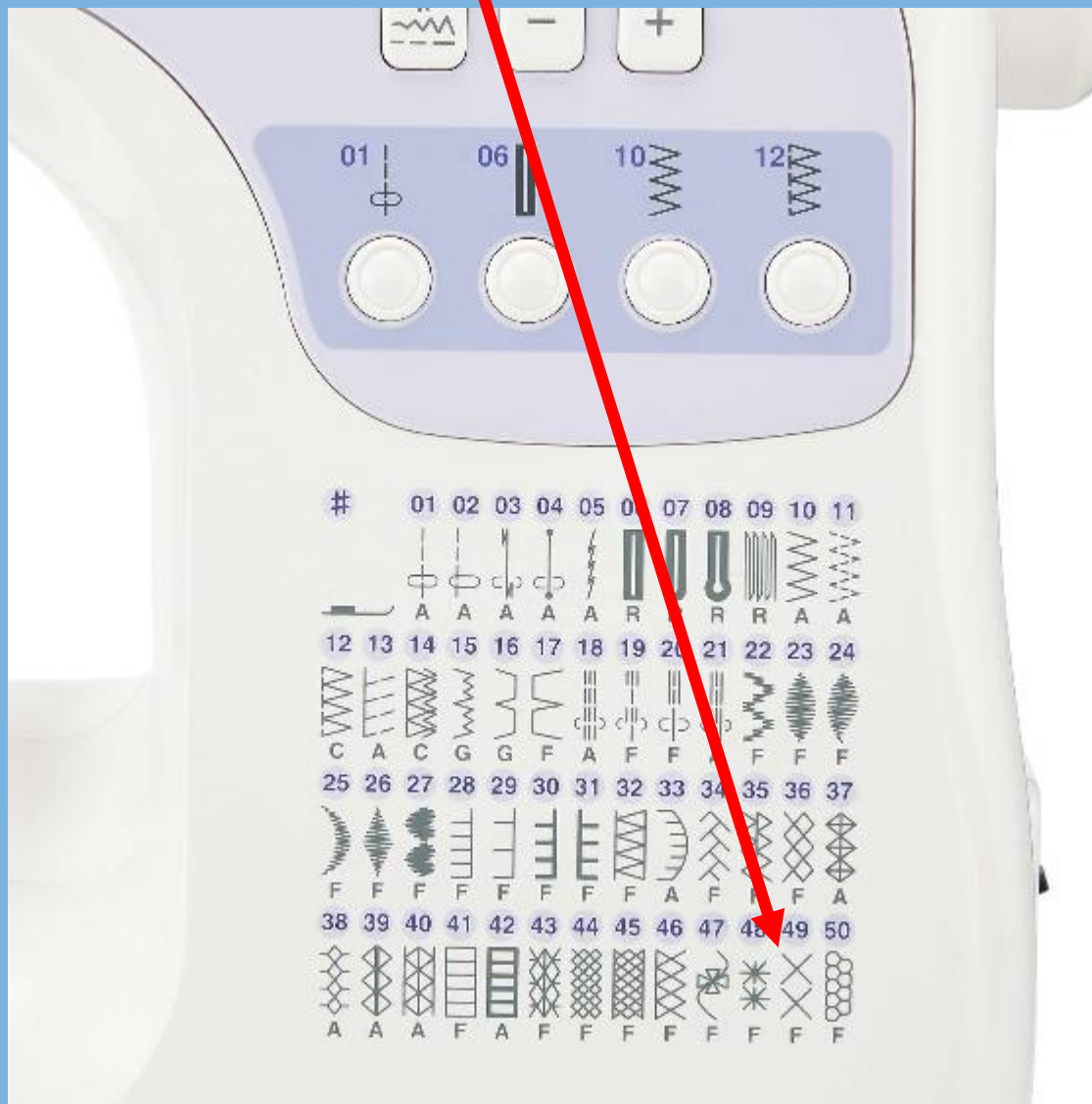
